Bromeliads are members of a large family of tropical and subtropical plants. They vary widely in appearance from the pineapple (Ananas) to Spanish Moss (Tillandsia). With some exceptions, they generally form a many leaved rosette with a water holding cup in the center. The flower spike is formed in the center of the rosette and after flowering the mother plant replaces itself or may send out up to fifteen offsets depending on the particular plant.

Bromeliads are easy to grow as house plants, requiring only good light and water in the "cups" at all times. These plants will also tolerate dark growing conditions for long periods of time. I predict in ten years this will be one of our leading house plants because of the ease in growing these exotic plants.

Code--In the extreme left column there will be the growing size of that particular plant in code as such; S-small, M-medium, L-large, XL-extra large and MIN for miniature.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS: Our normal shipping season is from April 15th through November 15th. We prefer not to ship during cold weather as there is a possibility of the plants freezing. If you as the buyer wish to accept this responsibility we will ship anytime. In the southern states where cold is not so severe we will ship when orders are received. Because of the large selection of bromeliads and quality of our plants there are times we are not able to process all orders promptly. We do make every effort to ship promptly and plan shipping so that packages do not arrive over the weekend. All shipments can be sent out by parcel post or air mail, postage charges extra. The price of the plant does not include postage. All foreign shipments sent by air only and you should write first so we can inform you of the papers needed prior to shipment.

Our liability in all instances is limited to the purchase price of the plants only. Cash with order, Minimum order \$7.50. We make every effort to get plants to you in perfect condition. We offer our 20 years of experience in this line but our responsibility ends when shipment is accepted by the carrier. Claims for damaged plants or undue delay in transit should be filed by the purchaser immediately with the carrier. All shipments travel at buyer's risk and expense.

We have been located and doing business here at this same address for the past thirty years. You get the benefit of our continual effort to select the choice varieties of these different plants and re-propagate them for our customers. We continually strive to hold the best clones of plants grown from seed for propagation so our customers will have the very best.
